As part of County's commitment to have a positive impact on the local community, at the end of July 2018 we once again volunteered to help One Can Trust food bank, based in High Wycombe.

The £1,500 we saved by not sending Christmas cards was directed to Wycombe Homeless Connection, who believe everyone should have a home.

On the 26 November 2019, the County Team spent the morning at their headquarters, hearing powerful stories about lives being transformed by Wycombe Homeless Connection's amazing work. It was humbling to see the organisation's determination to rebuild the lives of people who have slipped through the net in society, often due to no fault of their own. Seven town-centre churches in High Wycombe, take turns to welcome people off the streets each night, providing them with hot food and a bed.

Wycombe Homeless Connection's great belief is that prevention is better than cure and we are so delighted to be partnering with them as they receive very little
